Biography of Wenceslas

Wenceslas I 907 – September 28, 935

Wenceslas was the duke of Bohemia from 921 until his assassination in 935.

Wenceslaus was son of Vratislaus I, Duke of Bohemia from the Přemyslid dynasty. After the death of his father he was brought up by his grandmother Ludmila.

In September 935 a group of nobles - led by Wenceslas' younger brother Boleslav – wanted to kill the prince. Boleslav invited Wenceslas in Stará Boleslav, three of Boleslav's friends, murdered Wenceslas on his way to church.

Wenceslas was considered a saint after his death.

Třebíč is situated on both banks of the river Jihlava. It has many artistic monuments. Basilica of St. Prokopius is built in Roman-gothic style. Under this Basilica there is a remarkable crypt, where members of Přemyslid family are buried. Next to it there is a castle which now houses a museum with well-known exhibition of Christmas cribs.

In the central part of the town there is the fourth largest square in our republic with many historical buildings. The Black House and The Pointed House are known for their graffiti decoration.

Above this historical part there is a stately tower with clock, the face of clock is the largest in middle Europe.

The Jewish ghetto is very interesting too. It has two synagogues. Basilica and Jewish ghetto are on the list of Unesco. We have also large Jewish cemetery.

Třebíč is also a cultural centre. We have a theatre, a cinema and many cultural events are held during the year.

There are several elementary schools, secondary schools and a university in our town. And we have also many sport centres.

We think that Třebíč is one of the most beautiful towns in our republic.

Pupils learn Polish, English, Maths, History, P.E., Technology, Art, Music, ICT, R.E. and Nature of course :-)

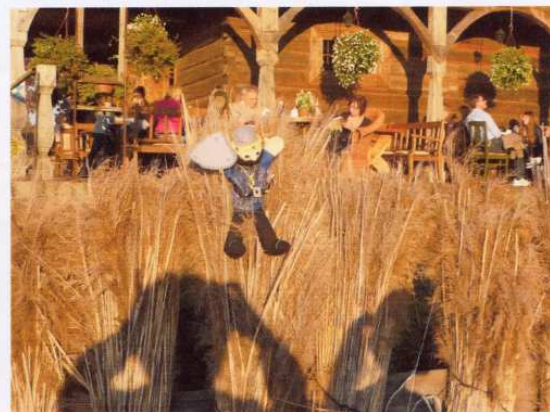


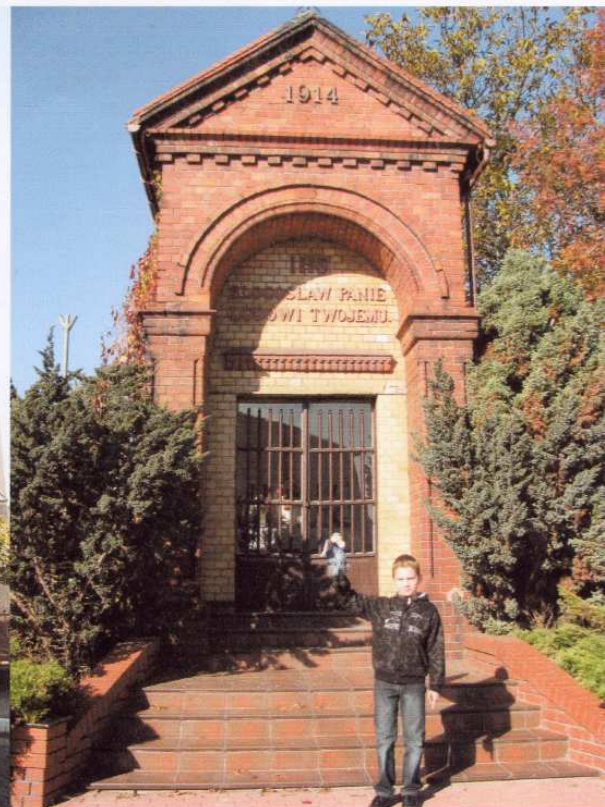
They like Art and Technology and make lots of nice pieces of art with hands...

On Monday evening, Gabriel took Wenceslas home to look at old objects and to meet his dog.



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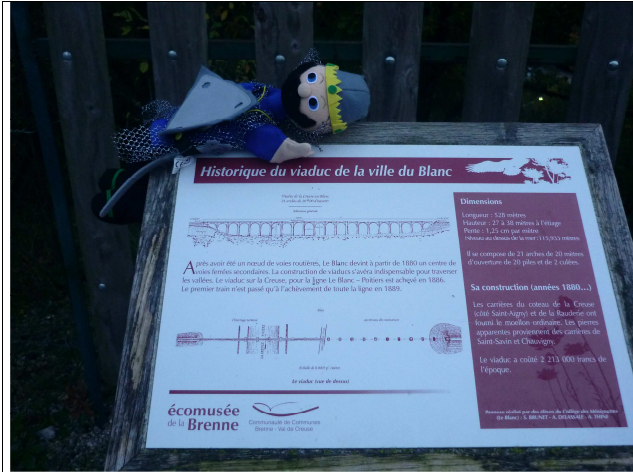
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At the weekend, Constance took Wanceslas at home and went around our town and in the country nearby.

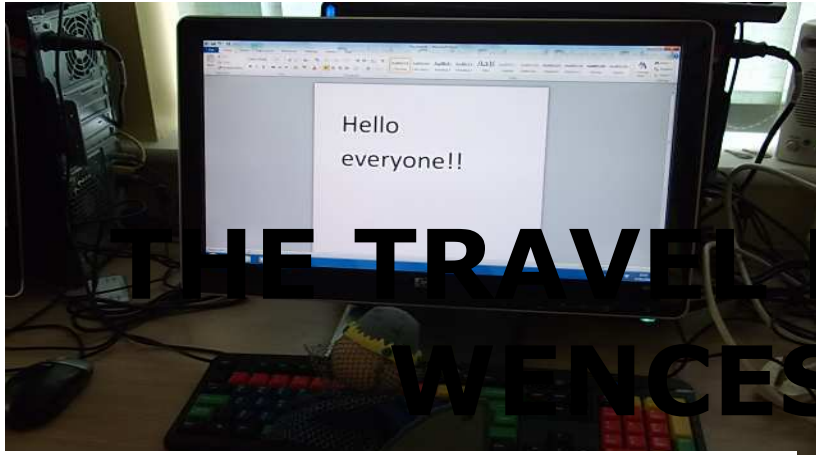
